Show the trash enclosure area on the site plan. All developments, except single family and two family developments, shall provide a refuse disposal area. Such area shall be screened on four (4) sides (including a gate for access) by a solid, commercial-grade wood fence, wall, or equivalent material with a minimum height of six (6) feet and not greater than eight (8) feet. Submit a detail of the trash enclosure.

Per Section 28.186(4)(b), the property owner or operator is required to bring the property into compliance with all elements of the approved site plan by September 14, 2018, as established by the Zoning Administrator. Work with Zoning staff to establish a final site compliance date.

Bicycle parking for the Veterinary clinic project shall comply with the requirements of Sections 28.141(4)(g) and 28.141(11). Provide a minimum of two short-term bicycle parking stalls located in a convenient and visible area on a paved or impervious surface. Bicycle parking shall be located at least as close as the closest non-accessible automobile parking and within one hundred (100) feet of a principal entrance. Note: A bicycle stall is a minimum of two (2) feet by six (6) feet with a five (5) foot wide access area. Provide a detail of the proposed bike rack.

All activity shall take place within completely enclosed buildings with soundproofing and odor control.
